Age of Opportunity- Pastor Brian

Philippians- Jan Leach

Philippians was Paul's instruction manual for the church at Philippi. Paul laid out expectations in the areas of conduct regardless of circumstances, attitudes, patterns and standards, standing firm in the Lord, and learning to have the mind of Christ to produce byproducts like joy and contentment.

Paul will motivate us to action as well in our spiritual lives as we apply these principles. This study will include character studies, word studies, and a study of the book of Philippians.

Forgotten God: A Study of the Holy Spirit- Pastor Nathan

Jesus explained to His disciples that the Holy Spirit would come to empower and comfort them by guiding them into all truth about Him. Unfortunately, many Christians are not characterized by a powerful, vital walk with God, but rather by a self-sufficient or even non-existent walk. What does it mean to be "baptized in the Spirit?" or to be "indwelt by the Spirit?" There is so much confusion and lack of knowledge about God the Holy Spirit that many Christians are fearful about studying and embracing the truth about Him. Unfortunately, this causes us to neglect the power and comfort of God in our lives. Join us each week as we explore Scriptural truth about the Holy Spirit and how He seeks to empower and enable us to be world-changing Christians for the glory of God.
